Troy suggested we use the Savage rifle (from Lance), a scope, and one of Norm's Gerber products for the hat raffle. We will use 40 of the hats that Wendell ordered. The matter will be voted on next meeting when more members are present.

Troy talked about the proposal from the La Grande Chapter to have each OHA Chapter donate money to their fencing project. It was decided to hold off on making a decision until next meeting, so we could have more information.
