Secretary Report- Clatsop County OHA will be holding a clean up of hunting areas on private timber company lands January 17, 2009 from 9:00am-3:00pm. Dane has contacted Western Oregon Waste, and they will donate the delivery charges of \$149.63 for the event. Members will work on getting a press release out to the media, advertising in the next OHA tracker, and on other web sources such as ifish. The clean up will take place on multiple timber company lands, not just Weyerhaeuser.

Treasurer Report- \$20,565.53 in the bank

NRA- Wendell picked up a print for \$75.00 from an NRA banquet to use as a prize at our next banquet. NRA membership has increased by 50,000 in the last month alone.

ODF- The Portland Chapter of OHA is talking with the Oregon Department of Forestry about improving habitat for deer and elk on state forest lands. Our chapter will look at what has been sent and send a letter to ODF addressing these concerns in addition to shooting range concerns (or lack thereof).

OHA Presidents Meeting- Due to extremely severe weather conditions predicted for this weekend, Wendell will not be attending the OHA president meeting in Bend.

Baha'i Faith Advertisements- Wendell passed around a letter from Grant County Chapter about the Baha'i Faith advertisements that have been in the OHA magazine. They felt that OHA should not be including religious advertisements in the magazine and have lost several members who objected to this. The board voted to support the Grant County's letter, and Wendell will email the state board about this matter.

Pendleton Chapter Banquet- We agreed to donate a gun and some thermoses to the Pendleton Chapter to help them with their first banquet.

Ticket Packages-We will need to decide on the prices for the particular ticket packages for this year's banquet. We will need to raise the dinner price from \$35 to \$40, and we will include a table package for \$700 which will include items to be decided on later. Wendell will be sending out an email to get feedback on the packages and prices soon.

Games-We will look at doing the same games as last year, but have a couple of Ruger 10/22 as prizes. The early bird, door prize, and rifle package will need to be worked out soon before advertising and selling of tickets for the banquet.
